In the far northern reaches of the country where Uganda meets Kenya and Sudan, the landscape is extraordinary and inspiring. Dramatic jagged mountains loom over golden savanna, peculiar conical hills sprout out of the grasslands, and prides of lions survey the scene atop rocky kopjes.

Kidepo Valley National Park is the most remote park in Uganda and one of the best places in Africa to see wildlife: giraffe, zebra, elephant, lion, cheetah, huge herds of buffalo, waterbuck, oribi, warthog and an incredible array of bird species all roam this vast wilderness.





The only lodge in the park, Apoka Lodge sits in the middle of this majesty. Strategically placed near the river, the lodge is an ideal base from which to explore the park and view the outstanding inhabitants.

Culturally this part of Uganda is fascinating. This is home to two distinctive ethnic groups with highly cherished traditions: the Karimajong and the Ik.

On foot, in the car, from your bath, from the veranda, from the edge of the rock pool...you will experience the wonder of wildlife in Kidepo, in Africa, in a truly wild place.
